CREATING CUSTOM NOSES

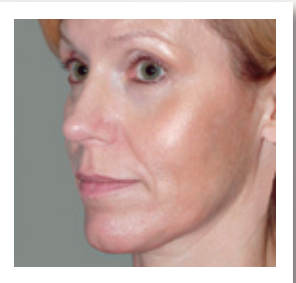

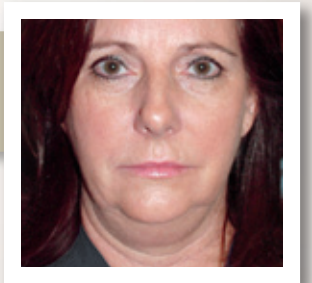

REVISION REFINEMENT

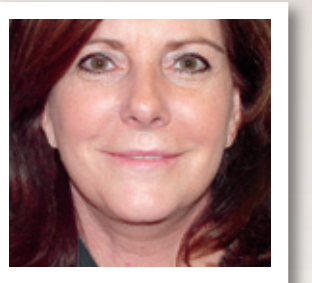
This patient, pictured seven months post-op, received revision rhinoplasty to correct airway and aesthetic concerns she had from a previous surgery on her nose.
